



# Buying Civica Software and Services using CCS Framework

A guide for public sector buyers



## Crown Commercial Service (CCS) frameworks

The CCS, an executive agency sponsored by the Cabinet Office, is responsible for **improving government commercial and procurement activity**. It runs a variety of framework contracts covering software services, consultancy services, and other technology services. When you buy through a CCS framework agreement, you can get guidance and support from CCS commercial professionals.

In general, any public sector body in the UK can buy from CCS frameworks, including:

- ▶ Local authorities
- ▶ Schools and academies
- ▶ Police and emergency services
- ▶ NHS and HSC bodies
- ▶ Central government departments and their agencies
- ▶ Registered charities
- ▶ Registered social landlords.

## CCS frameworks buying guide



The two options for buying CCS frameworks are the following.



**Direct award:** If there's a single supplier on the agreement or the option for direct award or call-off, you can place an order directly with the supplier.



**Further competition:** You can run a further competition against an existing agreement using the CCS eSourcing tool (or your organisation's own sourcing tool, if you have one). For some frameworks a further competition is the only way to procure services. When you run a further competition, you must award on the basis of the most economically advantageous tender (MEAT).

This CCS agreement is designed primarily to enable local authorities and councils to procure the software and related services they need to deliver citizen services and statutory functions.

As well as software, suppliers provide related services, including design, development, installation and commissioning of systems; ongoing support and maintenance; and some related business process services.

**You can buy a wide range of Civica software and services from this framework, which can:**

- ▶ Be hosted on your own infrastructure and managed by in-house teams
- ▶ Be hosted and managed by Civica in our secure cloud
- ▶ Be hosted and managed by a third party.



**Data and Application Solutions (DAS), will replace LASA/RM1059 in early 2019.**



## Lots

The framework is split into 11 lots. Each one covers the provision of software and associated services for one or more areas of local authority activity. Civica software and services are available under 10 lots:

Use the following weighting criteria.

| Criterion number | Criteria ranked in order of importance  | Percentage weightings (or rank order of importance where applicable) |
|------------------|---|--|
| 1                | Price (lifecycle costs, cost effectiveness and price; price and running costs)                                  | 40-60%   |
| 2                | Technical merit; coverage, network capacity and performance as specified in relevant service levels             | 0-20%  |
| 3                | Quality (including delivery time, sales service, good value, accessories, service fitness for purpose)          | 40-60%   |
| 4                | Help desk, account management function and assurance of supply of a range of devices and good value accessories | 0-20%  |

✓ Further competition

You can run a further competition (using the CCS eSourcing tool or your own tool) and award on the basis of MEAT. The CCS can provide you with help and support to:

- ▶ Develop your market proposition
- ▶ Develop the procurement on your behalf
- ▶ Undertake a reverse eAuction, if you choose to do so. (A reverse eAuction is where potential suppliers compete with each other by reducing the price of the goods or services. Prices gradually reduce during the eAuction, as suppliers offer improved pricing in order to win the contract.)

## Technology Services 2 — RM3804



The framework replaces RM1058, the previous Technology Services framework; and integrates RM1032, Enterprise Application Support Services.

### RM3804 is designed to help you buy:

- ▶ Managed IT infrastructure services, including end-user support, data centre infrastructure, networking and application support
- ▶ The managed approach and managed services involved in delivering programmes and large projects.

### This framework doesn't allow for procurement of:

- ▶ Public cloud services (private cloud services are available)
- ▶ Individual products.

### Lots

Lots 1 to 3 are structured around the lifecycle of a service: design, service migration and operational delivery. Lot 4 covers programmes and large projects.

The G-Cloud framework is an agreement between the government and suppliers who provide cloud-based services.

Civica offers 263 services across the three G-Cloud lots. The infrastructure, platform and software services available under lots 1 and 2 are commodity services. You can manage them yourself, or source a managed service provider using the RM3804 framework, [Technology Services 2](#).

When you buy services through the Digital Marketplace, you must be fair, open and transparent; and award contracts to suppliers who meet your needs.

### To buy through G-Cloud you must:

- ▶ Prepare your requirements
- ▶ Get approval to buy what you need
- ▶ Search for services on the Digital Marketplace using keywords
- ▶ Review services and use the filters to create your shortlist
- ▶ Compare services to find the lowest cost or the most economically advantageous tender (MEAT)
- ▶ Choose your service, award and sign the contract
- ▶ Publish the contract on Contracts Finder
- ▶ Complete the CCS benefits form

When you award a contract through G-Cloud, you must keep a record of all the buying process stages. You must be able to show a clear audit trail, including searches you've carried out, filters you've used, and how you've compared services.

The latest iteration of the framework is G-Cloud 10. So when you buy from G-Cloud, you must use G-Cloud 10 templates and legal documents.

### Note about terms and conditions

G-Cloud includes suppliers' terms and conditions. When you enter into a contract with a supplier, you accept its terms and conditions. However, if there's any conflict between the contract terms and conditions and the G-Cloud terms and conditions, the G-Cloud ones take precedence.)

### Contract term

Contract awards on G-Cloud normally last for up to 24 months. You may be able to extend a contract for up to two more years provided that:

- ▶ Your needs haven't changed
- ▶ A G-Cloud search shows that no other services are available

For a central government department to extend a contract, the spend controls team must agree, and the supplier must give you an additional exit plan to approve at least 8 months before the contract ends.

Use this framework to buy outcomes, specialists and user research services for digital projects.

### Civica offers all the services available on the framework for designing and developing digital services:

▶ **Digital outcomes**

eg a booking system or accessibility audit. Tell suppliers about the situation or problem and they'll propose a solution that meets your needs.

▶ **Digital specialists**

eg product managers or developers. Ask suppliers to provide a specialist for a specific piece of work. The specialist can't work outside the scope of your written requirements.

▶ **User research studios/labs**

Tell suppliers what facilities you need and when. They'll tell you if they can meet your needs and how much it will cost.

▶ **User research participants**

Tell suppliers about the types of participants you want to test your service with. They'll tell you if they can meet your needs and how much it will cost.

Digital Outcomes and Specialists suppliers provide services; you can't place these suppliers in permanent or interim roles. Specialists are employed or contracted by the supplier, who has responsibility and liability for the work done by its specialists.

## How to buy



When you buy services through the Digital Marketplace, you must be fair, open and transparent; and award contracts to suppliers who meet your needs.

Use the following weighting criteria.

### To buy digital outcomes, digital specialists or user research participant services:

- ▶ Prepare your draft requirements
- ▶ Get approval to buy what you need
- ▶ Publish your requirements on the Digital Marketplace, where they will be publicly available
- ▶ Answer suppliers' questions
- ▶ Review and score skills and experience to create your shortlist (ask suppliers for evidence if you need to pare down your shortlist)
- ▶ Invite shortlisted suppliers to the assessment stage
- ▶ Evaluate proposals and presentations to find the right supplier for your needs
- ▶ Award a contract and feed back to unsuccessful suppliers
- ▶ Publish the contract on Contracts Finder
- ▶ Complete the Digital Outcomes and Specialists benefits form.

### To hire a user research studio:

- ▶ Prepare your requirements
- ▶ Set evaluation criteria
- ▶ Get approval to buy what you need
- ▶ Search for user research studios on the Digital Marketplace
- ▶ Create a shortlist
- ▶ Contact the studios on your shortlist
- ▶ Answer supplier questions.
- ▶ Evaluate suppliers on:
  - Technical competence, based on location, facilities and accessibility
  - Price
- ▶ Find the winning supplier
- ▶ Award a contract and feed back to unsuccessful suppliers
- ▶ Publish the contract on Contracts Finder
- ▶ Complete the Digital Outcomes and Specialists buyer benefits form.

You must be able to show a clear audit trail, including any questions you've asked an evaluation you've made.
