Patron discovery

Personalised staff dashboard

Spydus home streamlines the administration burden and workflows by making tasks simpler to complete. It can also be used as an effective communication tool to deliver updates and announcements in a timely manner.

Event management

Event programming plays an important role in the service offering of the modern library. This module allows libraries to manage and promote all types of events and formats (physical, online, or hybrid) and processing of payments for ticketed events. The functionality also supports promoting events via social media sharing tools, email, and direct promotion to your community or specific library borrowers through calendar invites.

Book groups

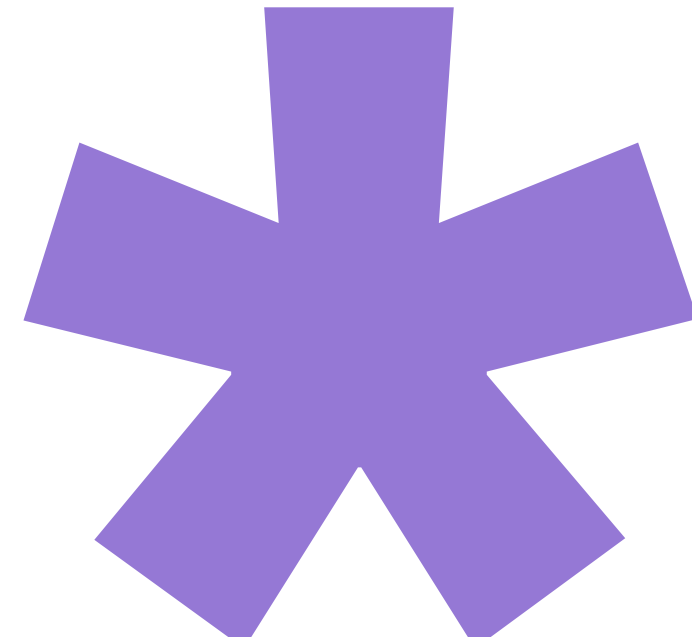

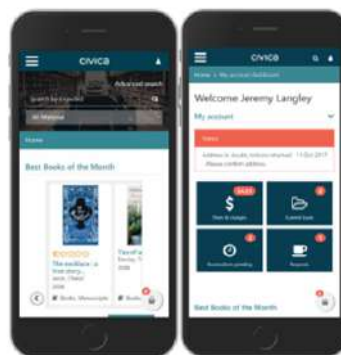
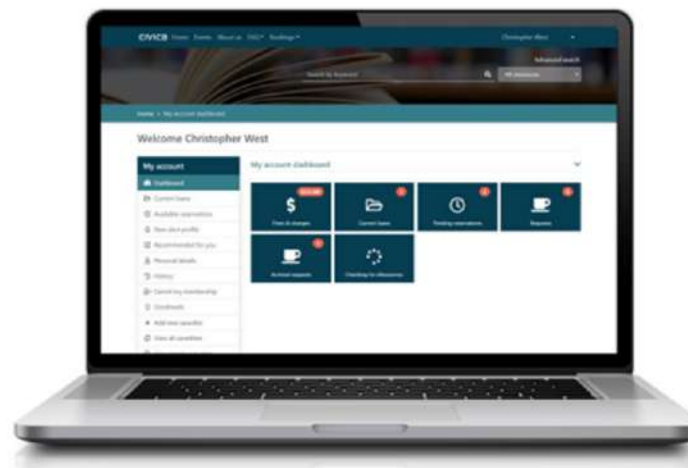
Business intelligence

SpydusBI is an interactive Business Intelligence tool utilising dashboards and charts to take the guesswork out of library decision making. Through our various modules, you will have the ability to understand borrower history, library's collections, and facility and equipment usage.



Public Interface (Spydus Discovery platform)

As part of the core Spydus system, the Spydus discovery platform draws both digital and physical items across core components into one seamless and unified Public Access layer search result. It provides the library user with a personalised experience once they are logged in, providing a loan, reservation, account details, alerts and title recommendations based on borrower profile and their borrowing history, as well as the ability to renew loans, place reservations, add reviews, place inter-library loan requests, place purchase requests, link out to social media, update their details, renewing their membership and much more. Borrowers can join online.



Staff Modules

The Spydus solution is one application and one database, that manages a range of library functions, library content and various metadata standards. This ensures real time, single points of metadata entry, with internal linked data enabling quick staff links to browse the system.

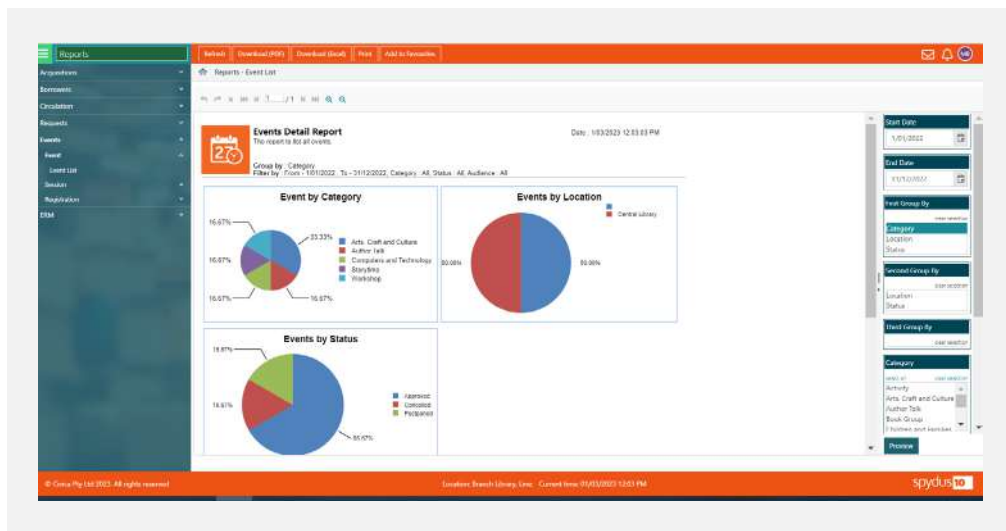
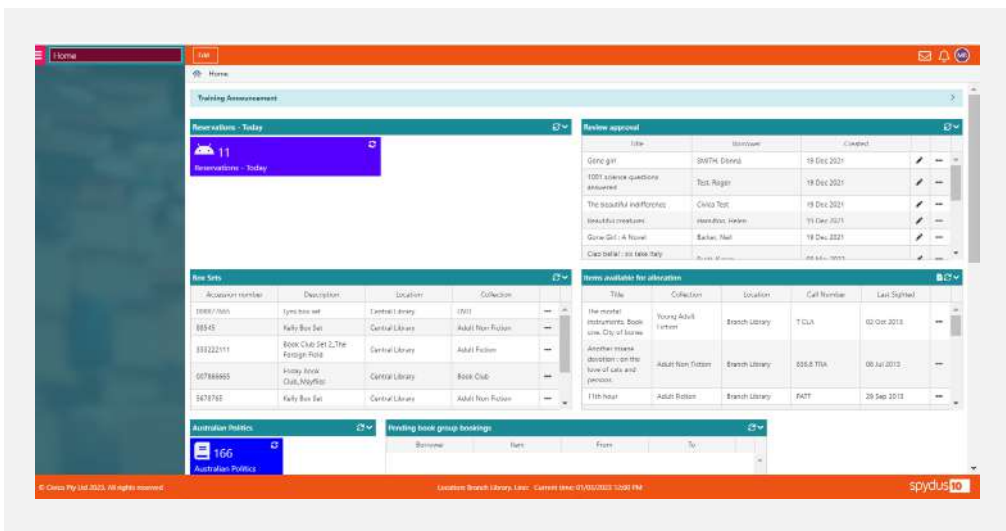
Spydus provides a single web entry point to all modules, that can be accessed on any page. User access to modules and functionality within each module can be controlled via privileges to ensure secure access.

Home

Home streamlines the administration burden making tasks simpler to complete. Authorised staff can post announcements and messages for other staff. Individual staff are able to build a custom menu of useful links and add widgets to their Home to view records such as pending invoices, waiver approvals, review approval, upcoming events, and more.

Reports

Within the core Spydus product, the Reports module carries an extensive range of standard operational and statistical reports that assist with the processes involved with all modules. All reports can be directed to network printers or transferred to desktop applications such as Microsoft Word and Excel.



Archives

As part of the core Spydus offering, the Archive Module is included to manage local history collections. It follows international archiving standards, ISAD(G). Archives have been designed to manage mixed collections of physical and digital items.

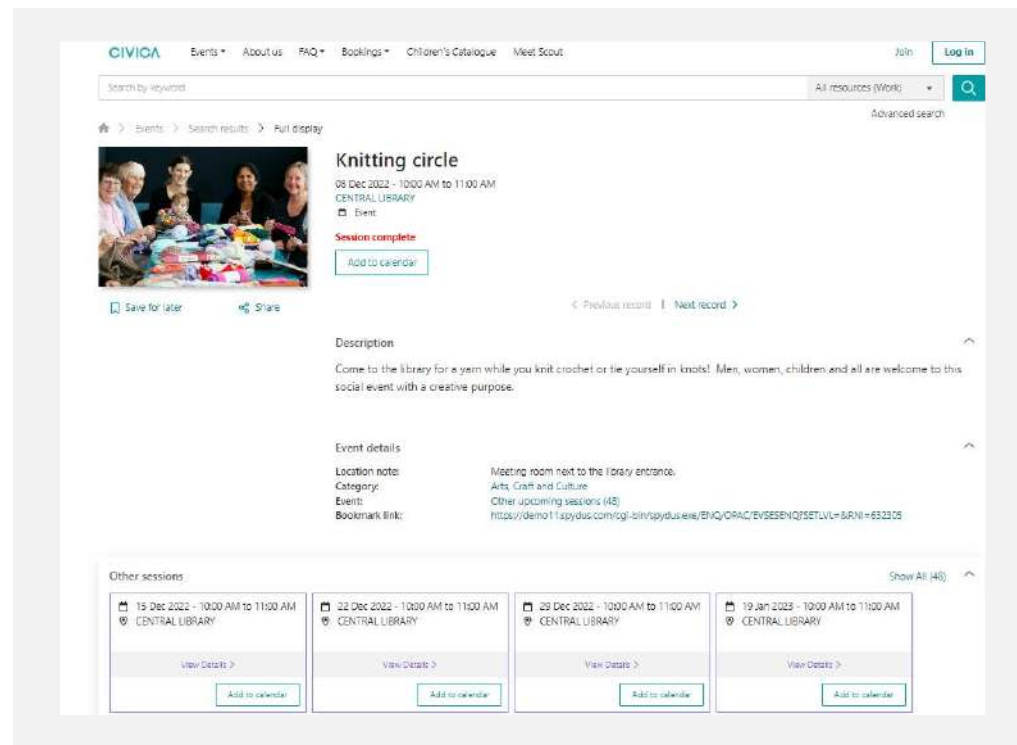
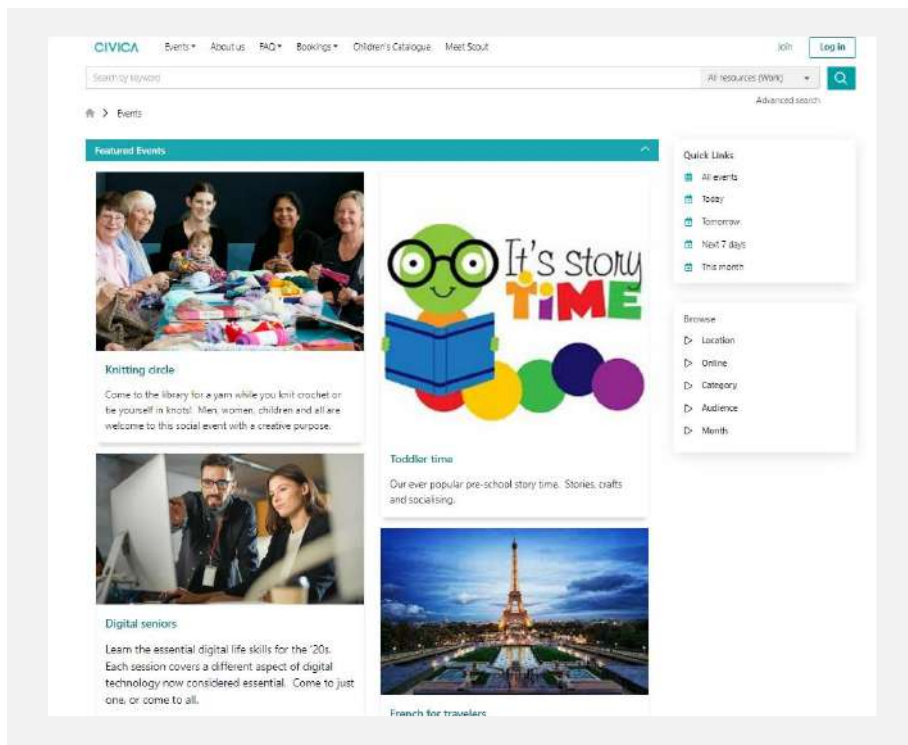


Additional modules

Events

Spydus Events allows libraries to manage and promote all events. Library users can:

- Manage one-off events, recurring events and series of events such as clubs.
- Manage waiting lists for events
- Take payments for chargeable events
- Promote events and target audiences using a range of categories
- Provide tickets for Events and record attendance either with the tickets or by scanning a user's library card
- Provide a feedback questionnaire following an event, and other email reminders and notices
- Use social media tools such as Facebook, Twitter and email, you can promote your events to the community or specific library borrowers, e.g. through calendar invites.



Spydus API

Civica is actively developing the SpydusAPI. This is a RESTful HTTP Web API service that allows third-party vendors to create both staff-based applications and patron-driven applications for interoperating with Spydus. Functionality includes patron authentication, retrieving patron information, check-out and check-ins of items, renewal, reservations and charges, event management, and more.


The patron-driven functionalities are predominantly based on BIC’s Library Communication Framework (LGF); however, in some circumstances, customisations have been made to extend the functionality of LCF, including modifications to some mandatory and non-mandatory elements to suit Spydus better.

Content Interfaces

Spydus e-content integration enables users to search, view availability, reserve, and borrow e-resources in a single platform search. For streamlined reporting, loan statistics for these resources are captured within Spydus, and users can view their digital and physical loans in a single library account. Spydus currently integrates with Overdrive, Axis360, RBDigital, Wheelers, Bolinda, cloud library, and RBDigital Magazines (Zinio).
